

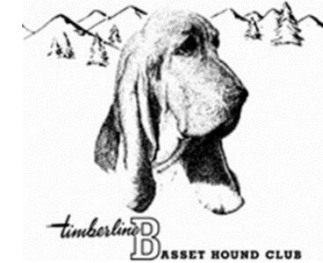

MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, **provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary not later than Monday, September 11, 2017 by 6:00 p.m. for the Saturday trial; and 30 minutes after the Saturday trial ends for the Sunday trial.** Dogs so moved will be at the end of the running order. Move ups may be emailed to the Trial Secretary (bristleconeassets@yahoo.com) and forms will be available for completion at the Secretary's table on the days of the trial.

WAIT LIST FOR WITHDRAWN ENTRIES AFTER THE CLOSING DATE/TIME

NCA and TBHC are offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to September 7, 2017. Any entry that has been accepted in one or both of the trials that is withdrawn by September 20, 2017, 6 p.m. MDT will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by September 20, 2017 will receive a full refund.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary between Wednesday, August 2, 2017 8 a.m. MDT and Wednesday, September 6, 2017, 8:00 p.m. MDT. Fees must accompany entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. A returned check will invalidate an entry and a \$25 service fee will be charged. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. Bitches in season are not permitted at the Trials. Entry fees, less the AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 (plus \$3.00 AKC Recording fee for second entry of the same dog) for bitches who come into season before these trials take place will be refunded provided the Trial Secretary receives written notification before Monday, September 13, 2017, 6:00 p.m. No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open due to any cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Newfoundland Club of America/Timberline Basset Hound Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Newfoundland Club of America/Timberline Basset Hound Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Newfoundland Club of America/Timberline Basset Hound Club, Trial Secretary, or any official thereof.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

These trials are open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing, Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

All dogs must be on leash at all times or otherwise confined when on trial/show grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course. Trial grounds are defined as the entire public area of Appletwood Park.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The trial giving club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing a service, through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

NCA and TBHC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or resource against NCA and TBHC or any official thereof.

Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the closing date of the trial, Wednesday September 2, 2017, 8:00 p.m. MDT. Those received by telephone are NOT acceptable.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Faxed, telephoned, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules attached to the official AKC entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to the acceptance.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at the show grounds.

Check-In will begin at 7:00 AM MDT both days. Judging will start at 8:00 AM MDT both days. Check-in for all dogs, judges' briefing, and walk thru will take place prior to start time. Excellent/Master STD and Excellent/Master JWW classes may have split walk through depending on entry size.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, Dogs that need to be measured must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

CANCELLATION OF AWARDS

If an ineligible dog has been entered and run in a licensed or member trial, or if the person or persons named as owner or owners on the entry form are not the persons or persons who actually owned the dog at the time entries closed, or if the dog is run in a class in which it is not entered or not eligible for, or if his entry form is deemed invalid by the American Kennel Club under the Rules and Regulations, all resulting awards shall be canceled by the American Kennel Club. If an award is canceled by the American Kennel Club, the entrant of the dog shall return all prizes to the Secretary of the trial-giving club within 10 days of receipt of notice from the American Kennel Club of said cancellation.

NOTE: Dogs which are off-lead outside of the marked ring area/warm-up area are subject to tickets and fines by Jefferson County Animal Control officers.

PARKING REGULATIONS

- Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner’s expense.
- Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles.
- Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times
- Exhibitors must adhere to all parking signs.
- NO DUMPING of holding tanks, grey water or sewage on the trial grounds.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. At the handler’s option, dogs may be entered in a higher division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
