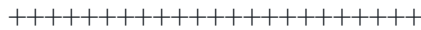
Brie also went NBQ in the field trial bitch class with a lot of competition. Betty and I are very proud of her.

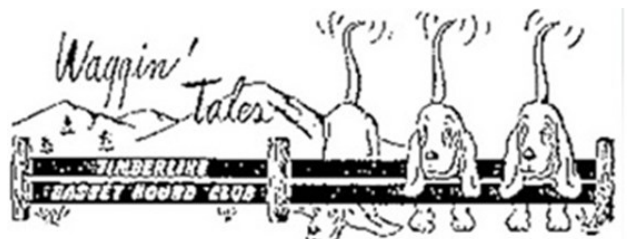
