Per Article IV Section 4 of the by-laws:  
*F. No person may be a candidate for more than one office. The additional nominations which are provided for herein may be made only from among those members who were not nominated by the nominating committee or who declined such nomination as above provided. However, no person who has declined the committee's nomination may be nominated by petition for the same position.*

*G. As soon as possible after February 10 or at least two (2) weeks in advance of the annual meeting, the secretary shall notify each member of all such additional nominations and shall publish again the report of the nominating committee.*

*H. Nominations cannot be made at the annual meeting.*
